BANKSIA (BANKSIA INTEGRIFOLIA) Max Height 10 mtrs

Attractive tree or hedge. Fast **growing**. Hardy to salt wind. Will grow in poor, stony soil and responds well to trimming. Should be planted together in a hedge in exposed sites. Plant 1-3 metres apart.

COPROSMA REPENS Max height 5 mtrs

A fast growing plant, ideal for exposed coastal conditions. Will trim up well into a hedge. Plant 60cm apart.

COROKIA GEENTYS GREEN Max height 2m

A faster growing Corokia with jade green foliage. Upright shape ideal for hedging. Makes a dense easy care hedge.

A hardy coastal plant, which makes a neat hedge if trimmed. Has pink bell shaped flowers. Plant 60cm apart.

ESCALLONIA WHITE KNIGHT Max height 2m

Fast growing with an upright form. Has a white flower. Ideal quick hedge or screen.

FLAX PHORMIUM COOKIANUM Max height 1.5 m

This is a smaller growing flax than tenax. Has more drooping leaves and yellow-orange flowers which are rich in nectar and can attract tui and bell birds.

GOLDEN AKE AKE (OLEARIA PANICULATA) Max height 3 mtrs.

With it's wavy lemon/green leaves this hardy native is a stand out. Has a moderate growth rate and makes a tidy trimmed hedge. Plant 60cm apart.

KARO (PITTOSPORUM CRASSIFOLIUM) Max height 4.5 mtrs

Top coastal hedge. Extremely salt hardy. Can be kept as a neat and tidy hedge. Will grow under trees, in shade in poor soils. Plant 60cm - 1 mtr apart.

LEMONWOOD (PITTOSPORUM EUGENOIDES) Max height 4mtrs

A fast growing species with attractive lemon-lime wavy leaves. Makes a great hedge. Will not handle salt-laden winds.

NORFOLK ISLAND HIBISCUS (LAGUNARIA PATERSONII)

Maximum height is 8 mtrs. One of the most handsome evergreen trees. Has an erect, pyramidal shape, average growth rate and is very hardy to wind and salt spray. Plant 2-4 mtrs apart.

Top pyramidal coastal tree. Its shape acts as a perfect wind filter. Will grow straight and true in harsh coastal conditions. Ideal for shelter or landmarks. Allow plenty of room when planting these.

OLEARIA ALBIDA ANGULATA Max height 3 mtrs

NZ native which has leathery wavy yellow-green leaves. Can be trimmed as hedge or grown with other natives. White flowers in autumn.
